The mandala is a circular form used in art across cultures. From cathedral rose windows and sacred Tibetan sand paintings to the shapes of blossoms, cells, and planets, mandalas surround us and reflect a geometry of inner/outer balance. Learn about these universal visual symbols as you explore your creative side by making your own circular holiday design. We will be using transparent silk hoops and colorful markers to create sun catcher ornaments.
